



## RPL Instructors

### Course Overview

The instructor's course is broken up into the following Phases:

Phase 1: Teaching Methodology – Train the Trainer

Duration: 2 Days

Briefing Preparation

Duration: 1 Day

Homework Preparation: 1-3 weeks in your own time

Phase 2: Pre-Flight Briefings

Duration: 2 days

Phase 3: Aerodynamic Briefings

Duration: 3 days

Phase 4: Practical Patter Training

Duration: 1-2 weeks (depending on instructor and student availability)

Phase 4: Skills Test

The skills test will include a Briefing presentation to be done for the examiner covering pre-flight briefings as well as an aerodynamic subject. The subject will be provided by the examiner prior to the test booking. Thereafter a practical patten flight as well as a proficiency flight will be done to complete the test.

Total estimated time 4-6 weeks to complete the full instructors Rating



**Note:** Candidates that hold a Manned Instructors rating will be able to exclude the Train the Trainer Modules during Phase 1 and can start with Phase 2.
