Phase 1

Teaching Methodology – Train the Trainer
Duration: 2 Days

Briefing Preparation
Duration: 1 Day

Homework Preparation: 1-3 weeks in your own time

Phase 2

Pre-Flight Briefings
Duration: 2 days

Phase 3

Aerodynamic Briefings
Duration: 3 days

Phase 4

Practical Patter Training
Duration: 1-2 weeks (depending on instructor and student availability)

Phase 5

Skills Test
The skills test will include a Briefing presentation to be done for the examiner covering pre-flight briefings as well as an aerodynamic subject. The subject will be provided by the examiner prior to the test booking. Thereafter a practical patter flight as well as a proficiency flight will be done to complete the test.
